this proposed adoption as described below.

CHANGE TO TEXT OF THE RULE: Section 6.5.1(A)(3) was added in response to the

ACLU's comments to clarify that RIAC is the final determinant of what information is

public under the Access to Public Records Act (R.I. Gen. Laws § 38-2 et. seq.).

REGULATORY ANALYSIS: This regulation is proposed to be repealed and a new

procurement regulation is concurrently being proposed for adoption. In the development

of the proposed repeal consideration was given to: (1) alternative approaches; (2)

overlap or duplication with other statutory and regulatory provisions; and (3) significant

economic impact on small business. No alternative approach, duplication, or overlap was identified based upon available information.
