## **Regulatory Analysis Summary and Supporting Documentation:**

The Rhode Island Airport Corporation proposes the adoption of these updated procurement regulations to align with requirements of the State Purchases Act. Compared to the Rhode Island Airport Corporation's current procurement regulations, the updated proposed regulation removes a large volume of statutory reiteration and internal policies/procedures which are not to be included in the regulation per APA requirements.
