MR. SAVAGE: So, welcome everyone. We're here today regarding a public hearing concerning proposed regulations entitled, "Rules and Regulations For Developmental Disabilities (212-RICR-10-05-1)."

This hearing is being conducted under the provisions of the Administrative Procedures Act,
R.I. General Laws Section 42-35-3. Today is
Tuesday, September 18, 2018.

My name is Kevin Savage, and I will be the Department Official for today's proceeding.

Before we start, and so as not to interrupt the proceedings, I would like to ask those of you with cell phones to turn them off at this time.

afford interested parties an opportunity to comment on the proposed regulations. This hearing is intended for your participation only, and is not intended as a means of providing a forum for discussing, debating, arguing, or otherwise having any dialogue on the record with members of the Department of Behavioral Healthcare, Developmental Disabilities and Hospitals.

If you would like to speak, the procedure 1 we will use is as follows: 2 Register outside the room. 3 Speakers will be taken in order of 4 registration. 5 Five minutes will be allowed for your 6 7 presentation. When you are called: 8 Come to the podium in front of the room. 9 Identify yourself by name and affiliation, 10 11 if any. 12 Make your presentation. If you have a written copy of your 13 statement, we would appreciate having that for the 14 Just give it to me at the front table, 15 and we will enter it as an exhibit. 16 After that time has elapsed for submission 17 of written commentary, the Department has four 18 options under state law: 19 The first option is file "as is" with the 20 Secretary of State. 21 The second option is to file with minor 22 23 changes. The third is to make changes in what you 24 see before you today, which would necessitate a 25

new public hearing.

The fourth option is to not file, in which case, the current regulations would remain in effect.

Unless otherwise specified by law or regulations, if filed, the regulations become effective 20 days after filing and have the force of law.

Are there any questions on how the public hearing will be conducted today?

(NO RESPONSE)

MR. SAVAGE: At this time, for the record, we will have a presentation of exhibits. I have submitted the exhibits.

One, a "Notice of Proposed Rulemaking" dated September 6, 2018.

A copy of e-mails sent to the "BHDDH Public Notice of Proposed Rulemaking" list September 7th, 2018 noticing the 30-day public comment process.

The third exhibit, a copy of the existing regulations, "Rules and Regulations for the Licensing of Developmental Disability
Organizations last amended December of 2016."

And, lastly, a copy of the proposed rules

entitled, "Rules and Regulations for Developmental Disability Organizations dated September of 2018."

At this time, I would like to call the first speaker. If I could get the list of speakers, I'd appreciate that. Donna Martin?

MS. MARTIN: Thank you, Director Savage.

I have a copy for the record. The comments that I have just provided -- well, let me restate. My name is Donna Martin, I'm the Executive Director for Community Provider Network of Rhode Island, and we are -- I am here on behalf of my members in support of the proposed regulatory changes.

The document that I submitted for the record encompasses our comments on both the licensing and general administration provisions in Chapter 10, as well as more specifically the DD Organization, Chapter 10, Subchapter 5.

Should I hold these comments to just the DD section or can I run through all of them?

MR. SAVAGE: Are you asking if you can comment on regulations for other groups?

MS. MARTIN: For the general.

MR. SAVAGE: No, hold that for the next hearing.

MS. MARTIN: So relative to Title 212,

Chapter 10 - Licensing and General Administration,
Subchapter 5, Developmental Disability
Organizations, we have several specific comments
and a couple of general. I'll start with
specifics. In the Definition section, Item #9
under "Behavioral supports."

This definition refers to "Core"
residential services, and we ask that this
reference be removed. We are concerned that it
was mistakenly carried over from previous
regulations as there no longer is a working
definition or service category of "Core"
residential services. We ask that the reference
to "Core" be stricken.

Definition #54: "Shared living arrangement contractor." This definition also refers to the "Core" residential services, and for the same reasons, we ask that that be stricken.

Definition #55: "Staff." It is our opinion that the reference to interns and especially to volunteers be removed from this definition as volunteers are clearly not staff or employees. They're not supported by the organization, and we ask that the intern and the volunteer reference be stricken from the

definition.

Item or Section 1.10.4 - "Respite:" Item

E. This section appears to require that all

respite providers be treated as agency employees

and meet specific employment and training

requirements. Currently, some agencies utilize

respite providers as independent contractors.

Implementing this section of regulation would

require a significant change in policy and

practice, and was not vetted as part of our

stakeholder process.

Item 1.11.3: "Documentation Standards and Maintenance of Health Care Records." Item D, the requirement of health care records to be maintained for ten years following the cessation of service delivery appears to reflect an increased requirement for record retention as we currently are required to keep such records for seven years following the cessation of service provisions. We ask that this requirement be modified to its original request of seven years.

And item 1.12.11: "Restraint Report."

Item A.4. a and b." Item A.4.a should be a stand-alone requirement in our opinion in this section as we are to monitor for signs and

symptoms of distress during any intervention even if injury is not resulting.

And Item b does not seem to make sense, and we question if there's an error. If not, we request that the Department elaborate on the intention and meaning of this requirement.

That concludes our specific comments on the General and DD specific proposed regulations.

We'd also like to, by way of general comment, commend the Department, the Division of DD, and specifically the Office of Facilities and Program Standards and Licensure for their fidelity to an open stakeholder engagement process as these regulations were reviewed and updated. The members of CPNRI and, in particular, those who were engaged in this process specifically, greatly appreciate the opportunity for sincere input and dialogue as we work towards creating a body of regulations that reflect contemporary best practice while setting the guide rails for person-centered practices and agency operations. Thank you.

MR. SAVAGE: Just a point of clarification. I believe the exhibit is the second session of this, not the full document; is

that correct?

MS. MARTIN: Yes.

MR. SAVAGE: Okay. Thank you. Mary Beth Cournoyer?

MS. COURNOYER: My name is Mary Beth
Cournoyer, I'm a parent. I also want to reiterate
what Donna said. I want to thank you for allowing
all of us to be part of this process. I think it
was held in fidelity, and I especially want to
recognize you because I sat on three different
subcommittees, and we had some fairly healthy
conversations, and I really appreciated that every
person was allowed input.

You recognized everything, and yet you were able to keep it in a way that it moved forward, and we didn't get bogged down and so forth. I'm grateful that as a parent I was able to participate. So, from a parent's perspective, what I want to say in the definition section, I noticed that you've kind of pared out some of the definitions where some are in general and some are DD-specific.

I understand why you did that, but there are things like the career development plan caregiver, et cetera, Bay State Service, all of

those definitions, if you're going to have them in another place, it might be helpful to reference that so that you want to make it easily understandable for all populations. So it's maybe not thoughtful to have them in another place with no reference as to where that place would be.

The other thing that I noticed is that in the old regs, you listed requirements of agencies. In the new regs, you listed Human Rights Committee and grievances as separate sections. Again, if I were going back and trying to understand the way things are written, I would want to know what are the requirements of the agency. So I probably would have left that as a heading, and then underneath of it explained Human Rights Committee with all of its regs and grievances because those are all part of it.

So, if I'm trying to understand where to go. If I'm not familiar with what a Human Rights Committee is, I don't really know what it's referring. I liked the way the old one was done. It was listing the requirements of agencies. The other piece on 1.4A, which is part of the Human Rights Committee, one of the things that we agreed to where it said the Human Rights Committee shall

have input on all organizations, policies pertaining to human rights, consistent with the provisions and so forth.

In the subcommittee, we added consistent with participant's learning style. So I think that's something that should be added in, and then on 1.8 regarding transitions, there are no specifics on timeline or transfer of information, so I think that needs to be put back in so it's more specific regarding transition.

MR. SAVAGE: Thank you very much.

MS. COURNOYER: Thank you very much for allowing me to be heard.

MR. SAVAGE: Those were the only two people who signed up to speak. Was there anybody else who would like to speak now?

(NO RESPONSE)

MR. SAVAGE: Any other comments?

19 (NO RESPONSE)

MR. SAVAGE: Okay. The submission of any written commentary on the proposed regulations will be accepted until the close of business on Saturday, October 6th, 2018. There was a question on what that actually means since the state isn't open on Saturdays, but that is the closing of the

period. So, we'll accept documents until the end of the day on Saturday; so until midnight on Saturday, October 6th.
