

## **CONCISE EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

### **RULES & REGULATIONS FOR THE CERTIFICATION OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE PREVENTION ORGANIZATIONS**

**REASON FOR RULEMAKING:** This is a repeal of the rule. This document is not  
regulatory. The standards are set out in provider contracts.

**ANY FINDING REQUIRED BY LAW AS A PREREQUISITE TO THE  
EFFECTIVENESS OF THE RULE:** N/A

**TESTIMONY AND COMMENTS:** No public comments were received on this repeal,  
therefore, no revisions have been implemented and no response regarding suggested  
revisions that were not implemented is required.

**CHANGE TO TEXT OF THE RULE:** There were no changes between the text of the  
rule as proposed and the text of the final rule.

**REGULATORY ANALYSIS:** In its determination to repeal this rule, BHDDH gave  
consideration to: 1) alternative approaches; 2) overlap or duplication with other statutory  
and regulatory provisions; and 3) significant economic impact on small business.

It was determined that repeal of the rule was the most appropriate course of action and would incur no additional costs.
