CHANGE TO TEXT OF THE RULE: Six minor changes to the proposed rule that were made to provide consistency and clarity within the proposed rule.

- Changing of language within Section 2.1.1 Authority by substituting the word under with pursuant to.
- Changing of language within Section 2.1.2 Purpose to remove "that are consistent with those" included the replacing of safety with science based and removal of certain text.
- Changing of language within Section 2.1.3 Applicability to remove "be liberally constructed to" and include "federal and".
- Changing of language within this Section 2.1.4 Scope to change the first sentence to read "These Regulations, in accordance with Rhode Island General Law 2-1-10, apply to every person who grows, harvests, packages and/or holds produce for human consumption on-farm, whether or not for profit".
- Changing of language within this Section 2.3 Definitions to include the federal definition for produce for consistency.
