Laws § 42-35-2.8, to consider the proposed amendment shall be held on May 6, 2019 at 7:00 pm at 235 Promenade Street, Room 300, Providence, RI 02908 at which time and place all persons interested therein will be heard. The seating capacity of the room will be enforced and therefore the number of persons participating in the hearing may be limited at any given time by the hearing officer, in order to comply with safety and fire codes.
