



## **FACT SHEET**

### **In re: Proposed revisions to 250-RICR-120-05-24, “Removal of Lead Based Paint from Exterior Surfaces”**

#### **Introduction**

The Department of Environmental Management (DEM), Office of Air Resources, is proposing to amend air pollution control regulation, 250-RICR-120-05-24 “Removal of Lead Based Paint from Exterior Surfaces” (Part 24). Part 24 specifies appropriate procedures for the removal of lead based paint from exterior surfaces.

#### **Description of Proposed Amendments**

There are no substantive changes to the regulation. The changes being proposed make definitions and applicability standards consistent with the Rhode Department of Health Lead Poisoning Prevention regulation, 216-RICR-50-15-3.

#### **Demonstration of Need**

By amending this Part 24 persons removing lead paint from exterior surfaces will be subject to consistent definitions and applicability in RI making it easier to determine if the rules apply.

#### **Alternative Approaches Considered**

No alternative approaches were considered.

#### **Identification of Overlapped or Duplicated State Regulations**

The Office of Air Resources has identified no state regulations that overlap or duplicate the proposed amendments.

#### **Determination of Significant Adverse Economic Impact on Small Business or Any City or Town**

The proposed revisions do not impose any new requirements on regulated entities including any small businesses or any city or town; therefore, there is no significant adverse economic impact.
