CONCISE EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

In accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, Section § 42-35-2.6 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, following is a concise explanatory statement:

RULE TITLE: GROUNDWATER QUALITY RULES

REASON FOR RULEMAKING: The purpose of these rules and regulations is to set groundwater quality standards for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances. These changes are necessary to implement legislation passed by the General Assembly during the 2022 legislative session. Specifically, RIGL § 46-32-5. Groundwater quality standards for per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances directs the Department to establish groundwater quality standards for certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances by December 31, 2023. The rules were amended to align the groundwater quality standard applicable to groundwaters classified GAA or GA with the interim drinking water maximum contaminant level specified in state law which is 20 parts per trillion for the sum of six specified PFAS compounds.
