- o Current ratio 1:1: Would result in 15 new endorsements available for issuance for 2026.

- c.Division proposalto require reporting compliance prior to the transfer of a new license uponsale of a license holder's vessel and/or gear (section 2.7.4(C)(5))
- d.Delete instances of obsolete licenses "Commercial Fishing License (CFL)" and "PrincipalEffort License (PEL)" as found in section 2.7.6 "Prioritization in theIssuance of New Licenses" (section 2.7.6).
- e. Division proposalto modify rule to clarify restricted finfish species (section 2.7.3(C)(1))
- f.Division proposalto adopt rules for the issuance of a commercial green crab license (section 2.7.3(A)(6) and 2.7.3(F)(15))
