Change between the proposed and final rule, including an explanation as to why these changes were made to the final text:

The final rule regarding Exemption Certificate expiration was changed from the proposed noticed of five years (expire in 2030) to ten years (expire in 2035) based on the recommendation of the RI Marine Fisheries Council.
