RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING BOATING IN THE TOWN OF SOUTH KINGSTOWN

Regulations Short Title: BOATING , TOWN OF SOUTH KINGSTOWN

AUTHORITY: These regulations are adopted pursuant to Chapters

42-35, 42-17.1, and 46-22 of the Rhode Island General

laws of 1956, as amended.

SPECIAL REGULATIONS VESSELS TOWN OF SOUTH KINGSTOWN

In accordance with and pursuant to the provisions of Sections 42-35-3 and 46-22-14 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, as amended, and following a public hearing in the Council Chamber, Town Hall, South Kingstown at 7:30 P.M., March 26, 1975, the following regulations are promulgated:

- 1. No person shall operate any motorboat with a motor in excess of 10 horsepower on the waters of Indian Lake, within the territorial limits of the Town of South Kingstown;
- 2. No person shall operate any motorboat, except a motorboat propelled by an electric motor, on the waters of Barbers Pond within the territorial limits of the Town of South Kingstown.
