Summary of Rulemaking Action:

This amendment adds Veteran's Disability Pension to "excluded income" in accordance with RIGL § 40-5.2-10, as well as updates language regarding CCAP for College which began as a Pilot program on October 1, 2021 with an expenditure limit of \$200,000.00, CCAP for College became permanent on July 1, 2022 with the passage of the FY23 RI State Budget. This amendment also updates the CCAP attendance policy. Below is a complete list of changes:

- § 4.6.2(A)(4)(b)((2)) Added language allowing for acombination of CCAP for College and employment
- § 4.6.2(A)(4)(c) Reformatted section and added languageregarding the acceptable need for CCAP for College on a two parent home
- § 4.6.2(A)(4)(d) Added language allowing for a combination of CCAP for College and employment

§ 4.7.1(A) Added "at recertification"

§ 4.8.2(A)(7), § 4.12.7(C), § 4.12.7(F) Changed "five (5 days)" to "two (2)consecutive weeks" and removed "per month"
