**Summary of Policy Change:** The Rhode Island Department of Human Services is updating the Family Child Care Home Regulations for Licensure. These updates incorporate the Rhode Island Start Early System (RISES) into the regulations, to revise outdated, unclear, or inconsistent language to improve clarity and usability, and incorporate the Group Family Child Care requirements.
