A public hearing, in accordance with R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-2.8, to consider the proposed amendment shall be held on November 7, 2018 at 2:00 pm at Department of Labor and Training, 1511 Pontiac Avenue, Conference Room 73-1, Cranston, RI 02920 at which time and place all persons interested therein will be heard.
