**Summary of Rulemaking Action:**

In Section 2.5.1 delete the word "annual" when describing the registration of boilers and pressure vessels, water heaters and storage tanks. They are not registered annually. In Section 2.5.14 C 3 and 4 replace the word biannually with biennially. In Section 2.9.19 GR-19 correct the mistyped year 2071 to 2017.
