

Hearing Officer Hughes:

Okay, we're going to get started at this time. Good morning, today is Tuesday, December 30th, and the time is now 10:33 AM. My name is Lindsey Hughes and I'm with the Rhode Island Department of Corrections. Joining me today from the Department of Corrections is Jessica Harrold, Principal Management and Methods Analyst, Brenda Baum, Acting Administrative and Legal Support Services Administrator and Michael Robillard, Program Assistant. We are here to receive public comment or public input with respect to the draft of Declaratory Order Petitions that the Rhode Island Department of Corrections has promulgated in a proposed rule for notice and comment. Also, it should go without saying, disrespectful or inappropriate behavior will not be permitted and will result in the removal from the meeting. If anyone has any questions about the proceedings, please ask at this time. Seeing none I will turn it over to Jessica to call on attendees to offer comment.
