Summary of Rulemaking Action:

The Rhode Island Department of Health ("RIDOH") is proposing rulemaking to include a new name for carcinomas cervix cancer and update the Central Cancer Registry Standards and Standards for Oncology Registry Entry to the most recent editions.

The Agency does not expect this filing to be controversial and therefore, a public hearing will not be held.
