Summary of Rulemaking Action:

The Rhode IslandDepartment of Health is proposing amendments to the regulation, Licensing ofNursing Homes in order to incorporate new references, add definitions for declaration of disasteremergency, direct care nursing staff, direct caregiver, essential caregiver, hours of direct nursing care, occupational therapist, physical therapist assistant, speech language pathologist, and vaccinated. Theregulation also provides procedures for COVID-19 testing for residents and personnel; provides procedures for essential caregivers during a declaredemergency; creates minimum staffing levels in accordance with statute; and requiresimplementation of an Alzheimer's disease plan.
