These regulations are being amended to include the following fees to comply with statutory changes:

- * Addition of fees for licensing genetic counselors
- * Addition of fees for licensing associate marriage and family therapists and clinical mental health counselors
- * Removing fees associated with the medical marijuana program
- * Adding a Cottage Food Manufacture registration fee
- * Revision fees for Radioactive Material, X-Ray, and Tanning Fees
- * Adding fees for two new COVID-19 testing methods
