

CONCISE EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

In accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-2.6, the following is a concise explanatory statement:

AGENCY: Rhode Island Department of Health

RULE IDENTIFIER: 216-RICR-40-05-4

RULE TITLE: Barbers, Hairdressers/Cosmeticians, Manicurists, Estheticians, and Instructors

REASON FOR RULEMAKING: These regulations are being amended to comply with amendments to R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-10-9 which reduces the number of hours required for a course of instruction in hairdressing and cosmetology.

ANY FINDINGS REQUIRED BY LAW AS A PREEQUISITE TO THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE RULE: N/A

TESTIMONY AND COMMENTS: No public comments were received.

CHANGES TO THE TEXT OF THE RULE: No changes have been made to the text of the regulation.

REGULATORY ANALYSIS:
