## CONCISE EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

In accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-2.6, the following is a concise explanatory statement:

**AGENCY:** Rhode Island Department of Health

RULE IDENTIFIER: 216-RICR-40-05-36

**RULE TITLE:** Practice of Electrolysis and Laser Hair Removal

**REASON FOR RULEMAKING:** The Rhode Island Department of Health is proposing to amend "Practice of Electrolysis" to include laser hair removal in the regulations based upon statutory amendments (Pub. Law 19-129). The amendments being proposed are based upon a statutory amendment to R.I. Gen. Laws Chapter 5-32 ["Electrolysis and Laser Hair Removal"] which added § 21 ["Practice of laser hair removal"] and amended several other sections. The statute which guides the proposed amendments differentiates between electrologists licensed before and after July 1, 2019.

## ANY FINDINGS REQUIRED BY LAW AS A PREEQUISITE TO THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE RULE: N/A

**TESTIMONY AND COMMENTS:** RIDOH did not receive any comments on the proposed regulations.

**CHANGES TO THE TEXT OF THE RULE:** No additional changes to the rule were made.
