

## CONCISE EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

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In accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-2.6, the following is a concise explanatory statement:

**AGENCY:** Rhode Island Department of Health

**DIVISION:** N/A

**RULE IDENTIFIER:** 216-RICR-50-15-5

**RULE TITLE:** Lead Inspections

**REASON FOR RULEMAKING:** RIDOH is revising the lead safe and lead hazard levels for dust on floors and windowsills to conform to EPA regulatory changes.

**ANY FINDINGS REQUIRED BY LAW AS A PREEQUISITE TO THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE RULE:** N/A

**TESTIMONY AND COMMENTS:** RIDOH did not receive any comments.

**CHANGES TO THE TEXT OF THE RULE:** No additional changes were made.

**REGULATORY ANALYSIS:**
