RULE TITLE: Lead Safe Work Practices

REASON FOR RULEMAKING: RIDOH is revising the lead safe and lead hazard levels for dust on floors and windowsills to conform to EPA regulatory changes.

ANY FINDINGS REQUIRED BY LAW AS A PREEQUISITE TO THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE RULE: N/A

TESTIMONY AND COMMENTS: RIDOH did not receive any comments.
