Summary of Rulemaking Action:

The Division of Motor Vehicles is amending the Rules of Practice and Procedure to revise the documents required to be submitted to obtain an operator's licenses, chauffeurs' licenses and identification cards. The DMV is also deleting sections of the Rules of Practice and Procedure regarding petitions for rulemaking and declaratory rulings as it will be promulgating separate regulations for these subjects in the near future.

Section 1.4.1(C) revises the list of documents that applicants can submit as Proof of Identity. The requirement to submit a document with a signature is eliminated.

Section 1.4.1(D) revises the list of documents that applicants can submit as Proof of Residency and requires two different documents to be submitted. Section 1.4.1(E) revises that list of documents that applicants can submit as Proof of a Social Security Number. Section 1.4.1(F) sets forth additional documents that applicants can submit as Proof of Identity to obtain a credential that does not meet the requirements of 6 C.F.R. Part 37.

A public hearing, in accordance with R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-2.8, to consider the proposed amendment shall be held on October 25, 2018 at 11:00 am at 600 New London Avenue, 3rd Floor-Administrator's Conference Room, Cranston, RI 02920 at which time and place all persons interested therein will be heard. The seating capacity of the room will be enforced and therefore the number of persons participating in the hearing may be limited at any given time by the hearing officer, in order to comply with safety and fire codes.
