The purposes of this rule are to prescribe the conditions under which the Medical Advisory Board shall conduct its proceedings and make determinations and recommendations relative to eligibility for handicapped parking privileges, and/or the applicant's fitness to operate a motor vehicle. The requirements for license reinstatement after three alcohol offenses contained in ERLID 1666 are added to this regulation.
