The purpose of this rule is to prescribe conditions under which a person may be qualified to operate a school bus transporting school children in this state in order to fully protect the health, safety and welfare of all persons riding school buses. The Division of Motor Vehicles is eliminating the requirement that persons 70 years of age and older successfully complete a road test every 6 months.
