Summary of Rulemaking Action:

The "Privacy Procedures Regarding Tolling" sets forth provisions that ensure information collected by tolling infrastructure is only used for the purpose of tolling and therein, remains private. The reasoning for the regulatory change is to update the time period of identifying correct vehicles subject to tolling because it is more labor intensive and time consuming than originally predicated.

Regulatory Analysis Summary and Supporting Documentation:

Societal benefit is that the increase of time to identify vehicles subject to tolls will result in more accurate billing thereby eliminating (or substantially reducing) any vehicles billed in error. There is no costs associated with this amendment.
