Summary of Rulemaking Action:

EOHHS will postpone the processing of annual Medicaid eligibility renewals that fall during the novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) declaration of emergency until the termination of the Federal COVID-19 declaration of emergency. This includes the suspension of periodic data checks for unemployment, SWICA, TALX and other sources and suspension of quarterly post-eligibility verifications. These provisions will not cease upon the termination of the State-declared Public Health Emergency, in order to ensure the continuation of EOHHS' eligibility for enhanced Federal funding.
