

## CONCISE EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

---

In accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-2.6, following is a concise explanatory statement:

**AGENCY:** Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS)

**DIVISION:** Medicaid Policy Unit

**RULE IDENTIFIER:** 210-RICR-50-00-8

**RULE TITLE:** Chapter 50 – Medicaid Long-Term Services and Supports, Subchapter 00 – Long-Term Services, Part 8 Post-Eligibility Treatment of Income (PETI)

**REASON FOR RULEMAKING:**

The regulations are being adjusted to reflect the elimination of the Category F program. In addition, since Category F members had received supplemental payments that were allocated to room and board, the regulations are being amended to reflect the updated maximum amount for the Special Maintenance of Needs Allowance for room and board.

**ANY FINDING REQUIRED BY LAW AS A PREREQUISITE TO THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE RULE:** N/A

**TESTIMONY AND COMMENTS:** No objections or comments were received.

**CHANGE TO TEXT OF THE RULE:** No objections or comments were received. Therefore, the final rule is the same as what was proposed.

**REGULATORY ANALYSIS:**

This regulation does not impact small business. In the development of the proposed adoption, consideration was given to: (1) alternative approaches; (2) overlap or duplication with other statutory and regulatory provisions; and (3) significant economic impact on small business.
