REASON FOR RULEMAKING:

Pursuant to **42 U.S.C. §415(i)**, the federal government is required to make COLA adjustments to SSI benefits. As a result, we must reflect those updates in our regulations. This amendment makes the annual update to Medicaid regulation to reflect the 5.9% cost-of-living increase for 2022 on the State Supplementary Payments and the Medically Needy Income Limit.
