As part of the FY23 Budget signed by Governor McKee, EOHHS is required to provide the following:

Coverage to all children that are residents of Rhode Island

ANY FINDING REQUIRED BY LAW AS A PREREQUISITE TO THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE RULE: N/A

TESTIMONY AND COMMENTS: No objections were received. Supportive comments stating that this amendment will provide greater access to care for children with disabilities and chronic conditions and help them live fuller lives, and support the financial and emotional stability of their families, were received.

CHANGE TO TEXT OF THE RULE: The final rule is the same as what was proposed.

REGULATORY ANALYSIS:

This regulation does not impact small business.
