

CONCISE EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

In accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act, R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-2.6, following is a concise explanatory statement:

AGENCY: Executive Office of Health and Human Services

DIVISION: Medicaid

RULE IDENTIFIER: 210-RICR-30-00-1

RULE TITLE: Medicaid Affordable Care Coverage Groups Overview and Eligibility Pathways

REASON FOR RULEMAKING: Effective 1/1/23, the SUPPORT Act directed states to provide Medicaid eligibility for individuals turning 18 after January 1, 2023 who qualify under the former foster care children (FFCC) eligibility group if they were enrolled in Medicaid at the time they aged out of the foster care system in any state. Previously, this coverage requirement only applied to individuals who aged out of the Rhode Island foster care system.
