| Office of Health and Human Services proposed Amendment |
| to Regulations entitled, Medicaid Payments and |
| Providers (210-RICR-20-00-1). This hearing is being |
| conducted under the provisions of Chapters 40-6, 40-8, |
| and 42-7.2 of the Rhode Island General Laws; and Title |
| 42, Part 455, and Title 42, Part 424.518 of the Code of |
| Federal Regulations. Today is Thursday, December 21st, |

The purpose of the hearing today is to afford interested parties an opportunity to comment on the proposed Amendment to the Regulations. This hearing is intended for public participation only, and is not intended as a means of providing a forum for discussions, debating, arguing, or otherwise having any dialog on the record with members of the Executive Office of Health and Human Services.

If you care to speak, the procedure we will use is as follows: If you have not done so already, please register at the side of the room. Speakers will be



taken in order of registration. Five minutes will be allowed for your presentation, unless a lack of speakers allows for additional time. When you are called, come to the podium at the front of the room, identify yourself by name and affiliation, if any, then make your presentation. If you have a written copy of your statements, we would appreciate having that for the record.

After the time has elapsed for submission of written commentary, the Executive Office of Health and Human Services has four options under state law: The first option is to file the proposed Amendment as is with the Secretary of State's Office; the second option is to file the proposed Amendment with minor changes; the third option is to make major changes in what you see before you today, which would necessitate a new public comment period; the fourth option is to not file, in which case, the current Regulations would remain in full force and effect. If filed, Amendments become effective 20 days after filing, and have the full force of law. At this time, are there any questions regarding how the public hearing will be conducted today?

At this time, for the record, we will have a presentation of Exhibits: Exhibit 1 is the Public



1 Notice of Proposed Rulemaking posted on the Rhode 2 Island Secretary of State's website and the Executive 3 Office of Health and Human Services' website on 4 December 8, 2023. This Notice indicates a 30-day 5 public comment period that runs through January 28, 2024, and indicates that a public hearing will be held 6 7 on December 21, 2023, at 1:00 p.m. Exhibit 2 is a copy 8 of an e-mail sent on December 8, 2023, to distribute the Public Notice, and inform the Executive Office of 9 10 Health and Human Services' interested parties list 11 regarding the proposed Amendment.
