REASON FOR RULEMAKING:

On 5/18/23, Governor McKee signed the Equality in Abortion Coverage Act which directed EOHHS to cover abortions for Medicaid beneficiaries. Federal law restricts coverage of abortions to instances of rape, incest, or in order to preserve the life of the mother. The State will pay for coverage of all other abortions with state only dollars.
