Title 23 Chapter 18-11.2 of the General Laws of Rhode Island

Summary of Rulemaking Action:

This regulation establishes standards for cities and towns to register and regulate historic cemeteries in the absence of a local ordinance. This rule is being reformatted for inclusion in the Rhode Island Code of Regulations. In the development of the proposed amendment consideration was given to: (1) alternative approaches; (2) overlap or duplication with other statutory and regulatory provisions; and (3) significant economic impact on small business. No alternative approach, duplication, or overlap was identified based upon available information.
