## **CHANGE TO TEXT OF THE RULE:**

Office of Veteran Affairs name updated to Office of Veteran Services in the Title of the rule as well as in: 1.1(A), 1.1(C), 1.1(D), 1.1(E), 1.1(F), 1.5(B)(1), 1.5(C)(1) (b)(2), 1.7(A).

- 1.2 (A)(5) was added to include RI residents, or former residents, who served as
  a commissioned officer of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration
  or the Public Health Service for a period of not less than two year and was
  discharged under honorable conditions as person eligible for burial at the RI
  Veterans Cemetery.
- Clarification in section 1.6 (E)(2) that the restrictions related to decorative items at the cemetery are by the federal, not state, Department of Veterans Affairs.
- Rewording of the document to more clearly define the administering of the Veteran Cemetery
