These Rules and Regulations are intended to provide the public with information regarding the manner in which the Rhode Island Turnpike and Bridge Authority, in its discretion may collect tolls by cash or credit card. Specifically, the Authority, in its discretion, may close cash or credit card lanes and direct traffic through EZ-Pass lanes, and, in such circumstances, invoice the registered vehicle owner the amount of the toll, minus the administrative fee. The Authority does not expect this rule to be controversial.
